FINE ARTS EDUCATION

7th edition of the popular summer schools focused on education and experiential cultural experience

Venue: Faculty of Education, Palacký University Olomouc, Czech Republic

Duration: July 11 – August 10, 2025

Capacity: 16 students per class max

ECTS credits: 8

Brief content

The aim of this course is to inspire participants to foster intercultural ties while emphasizing the importance of mutual understanding and cooperation in building a better future for everyone. To this end, the participants will be given the opportunity to improve their English language, experience Western culture first-hand and express their relationship to their own culture through a collection of art creative activities. In particular, participants will work with classical art media such as drawing, painting, ceramics, sculpture, print art, spatial art, textile art. Furthermore, they will also be afforded the opportunity to experience new media art and art activities realised within museum education in museums and galleries.

General topics and themes of the course:

- Drawing, painting
- Print art
- Ceramics, sculpture
- Textile art
- Museum and gallery education

All teaching, exercises and activities are provided in English.

The programme fee for one participant:

- Applications sent by December 31, 2024 – the payment of a non-refundable deposit 50 EUR and then the additional payment 980 EUR.
- Applications sent between January 1 and March 15, 2025 – the fee of 1 130 EUR.

Programme fee includes:

- Accommodation in a triple room (up to 5 weeks)
- Lecturing and workshops
- Trips to Prague, Vienna and Lednice – Valtice Area
- Visits to ZOO, bowling, laser arena, rope park, aquapark, Fortress of Knowledge
- Certificate of attendance and transcript of records (with ECTS credits)

Programme fee does not include:

- Food
- Travels costs to and from Olomouc
- Costs for obtaining passport, visa or other travel documents, insurance etc.

The participants must have travel, medical and accident insurances.
